

- You should wear long sleeve clothing and long pants. Dark colors or camouflage work best. Layer your clothes so that you can shed clothing as it gets warmer.
- For sensitive body areas, men are recommended to wear a protective cup and women are recommended to wear a fem guard.
- Elbow, knee, and shin pads are also useful.
- Gloves are helpful to protect hands.
- Comfortable shoes with good ankle support.
- Water to drink and snacks to munch on.
 Camera or camcorder to record the special day.
- Sunglasses and sunscreen for sunny days.
- First aid kit and paper towels.
- A change of clothes for afterwards.
- Large garbage bag for dirty clothes.
